

# Upcoming Statute Changes FAQ

**Q**-My LCSWA license expires on or after 12/31/2020 and I have not taken and passed my exam. What do I need to do?

**A**-Prior to your assigned expiration date (this date is located on your certificate and license verification), you will need to renew the LCSWA license. Once the LCSWA license is renewed and you have documented two years of clinical practice to the Board, you may submit for examination eligibility. The form to submit will be available on the Board's website after 01/01/2021.

**Q**-What if I previously held a LCSWA license but was unable to pass the exam prior to the expiration date. What do I need to do now?

**A**-After 01/01/2021, you may submit a new application packet to the Board office for issuance of the LCSWA license. Once you have documented two years of clinical practice to the Board (post issuance of the new LCSWA license), you may renew the LCSWA license and apply for examination eligibility.

**Q**-What if my previous LCSWA license expired, but I have submitted a new application and have exam eligibility through 12/31/2020. What do I need to do to be issued a new LCSWA license?

**A**-The Board will be sending notice and instructions regarding issuance of a new LCSWA license to all individuals with current applications on record. **If you have had a change of address but have not reported to the Board office, please do so immediately to assure that you will receive this notice.** If you have not taken and passed the Clinical exam, you may still be issued a new license after 01/01/2021.
